KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Programming a week-long Kids Camp in August.** This involves booking special services, planning curriculum, recruiting and leading a volunteer team, advertising, as well as hands-on work with the kids.
- Assisting with a Thursday evening drop-in program for kids. This involves preparation help and hands-on work with the kids every Thursday evening from mid-May to August.
- **Summer Church Camp out**. Work with the youth intern to assist in planning and organizing activities, advertisement and registration for the Bethel Church camp out.
- Assist in planning and facilitating the Annual Canada Day Carnival.
- Modeling a Christ-directed life.
- Overseeing volunteers and other summer staff in the Children's Ministry area, including camps and Sunday services.

Additional Responsibilities/Requirements:

- Attend weekly staff meetings and other meetings as determined by Lead Pastor and Children's Directors.
- Must submit to a full Police Security Check and a Child Intervention Check
- Will work closely with the other Children's Ministry staff and summer interns.
