Dear Bethel,

On July 4 we will be having our first Sunday with in-person kids! Since this will look a little different from the past, here is an update about what to expect:

Each Sunday we will be inviting our Bethel Kids to join us downstairs for their very own worship service starting at 10 am on Sunday Mornings. Most ages will be together initially. Later in the Summer, we will break out into age groups. For July 4, you can pre-register your kids [here](#). When you arrive, go to the check-in desk to grab your child's name badge. Then head down stairs to join our leaders and other kids. At the end of the service, come down the stairs through the back of the sanctuary, collect your child, then head upstairs using the stairs by the main doors.

If you are joining us from home we have linked the video resource that Bethel Kids will be engaging with this Sunday. Since the video will not run during the service, we recommend parents set up a way for watching this, perhaps during the sermon. We also have a "Challenge Card" on our children's page that has some activities and devotionals for you and your family to do during the week. These will be updated each week so that whether you're in person or joining from home, there's way for for your kids to learn and grow in their faith.

We're currently working on a plan for nursery and toddlers:

- This upcoming Sunday, July 4, the nursery room will be open for parents to be there with their children during the service.
- Starting on July 11, we will have our nursery available for your infants and toddlers! When you arrive at church check your kids in at the registration desk, and then bring your children to the nursery for care from our volunteers.

We will need your help this summer. Please contact me to let her know when you can volunteer. I am also happy to answer any questions you have about what bringing your kids to church will look like this Summer.
