We are happy to inform you and the church that the sea can containing medical supplies for the health center arrived in Monrovia on Monday May 20, 2024.

It was released late on that Monday and the container's journey to Bettesu began on Tuesday May 21, 2024. Despite the difficult challenges with the bad road, the container made it safely to Foya on May 22, 2024 and went as far as 15 km to Bettesu when the truck driver decided that he would not go further due to the bad road. The truck was offloaded last night May 22, 2024 and tomorrow morning, we will begin loading on smaller vehicles to Bettesu which is only a 15 km distance to cover.

On behalf of the BTL board members, we are extremely grateful to God for safe arrival of the sea can and to the church and all our donors for making the funds available to transport this container to Liberia and to Bettesu. We are also very grateful to our only board member in Liberia, Justin Kotio for his patience and careful coordination of activities on the ground in Liberia. You can see some pictures of the container below where it was offloaded surrounded by strong men from Bettesu village.
