## THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This Sunday we begin our fall sermon series, *Everyday Disciples*. We will explore the call on and the lives of Jesus' first disciples through the Gospel of Matthew. Through this journey we will see how Jesus called his disciples, how he loved them, and how he led them to a new life shaped by the cross.

There are distinct marks of Jesus' disciples which we should expect to see in our own lives as we apprentice ourselves to Jesus in community. These marks point to a profound reminder: no matter what season we find ourselves in, we are called to grow every day as we follow Him.

The message this Sunday will focus on Matthew 4:18-22, "Come, Follow Me."
