I THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This Sunday we begin a new sermon series for Lent, *I AM*. Each of the statements Jesus makes about himself in the Gospel of John invite us to follow Christ more fully because of who he is and not what we would prefer him to be. We start this series by looking at Jesus as the "bread of life," the source by which all hunger can be satisfied, and every thirst quenched. Jesus reminds us that God is the ultimate provider for all our needs. If we turn to him in faith, we will receive everything we need. We are who God says we are (in Christ) because God is who he is, the great I AM (cf. Exodus 3:14).

The message this Sunday will focus on 6:25-59, "I AM the Bread of Life."
