I THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This Sunday starts our new initiative **40 Days of Belonging**. Each week we will explore a key value that shapes who we are becoming as a church family: a "House of the Lord" – which is what Bethel means – and a "House of Belonging." Our goal is to re-affirm what this means for every person at Bethel and allow unity for what we care about most to guide our lives together in Christ.

We begin by looking at what it means to embrace **Life Together** in community. Though there are many of us, we belong together as one body since we all have been found in Christ. Christ's love compels us to pursue, build, and participate in an authentic community. A community of belonging in Jesus. If this is true, then *why do so many of us often feel so isolated*? The truth is we have some "house building" to do when it comes to our relationships so that we better reflect, practice, and share Jesus with one another. We must seek our community to flow out of intentional unity in Christ, and not human desires.

The message this Sunday will focus on Romans 12:4-16, "Life Together."
