THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This is the second message in the series on 1 Thessalonians, ***Built Different***. In the midst of suffering, Paul strengthens his resolve to ensure that followers of Jesus know they are entrusted with the precious and powerful gospel. Today, we can't afford to waste time pleasing people. God must be our focus, so that not only will we be saved but everyone else around us might be saved. We're entrusted with a gospel that shapes the culture around us! Paul writes with joy, encouragement but also challenge so that followers of Jesus might be equipped for the road ahead and pursue a life of closeness to Jesus that's *built different*.

The message this Sunday will focus on 1 Thessalonians 2:1-20, "Entrusted with the Gospel".
