O THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This Sunday we continue our fall sermon series, *Habits of the Church*, by reflecting on the practice of generosity in the early church. The Book of Acts gives us a picture of a church alive with purpose, passion, and power, modeling six habits that shaped the early church: devotion to God's Word, life-giving fellowship, the breaking of bread (hospitality), powerful prayer, generosity and worshipful witness. These were not occasional activities but consistent rhythms that formed a Spirit-filled community and made the gospel visible to the world. In this series, we'll discover how these same habits can shape us today into a church that is committed to becoming like Christ and sharing Him with others.

The message this Sunday will focus on Acts 4:32-35, "And to Generosity."

BETHEL FAMILIES: Among the many significant practices of the church, celebration the Lord's Supper beautifully captures God's grace and his acceptance of us in Christ. We want to emphasize this more and more for children growing up in Bethel. Children are welcome to receive communion just as God welcomes them. We will plan for upcoming services that include celebrating the Lord's Supper (typically the last Sunday of the month) to also have sufficient time for parents to check out their children from Bethel Kids after the message. The first service where we will intentionally invite families to include their children as part of the Lord's Supper will be on September 28, 2025.
