1 THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This Sunday we continue our sermon series for Lent, *I AM*. Each of the statements Jesus makes about himself in the Gospel of John invite us to follow Christ more fully because of who he is, and not what we would prefer him to be. Next, we look at what it means for Jesus to be the "Good Shepherd."

The analogy of a Shepherd brings about images of being led and cared for. What does it mean to be one of God's sheep? The message this Sunday we will explore the "I AM" statement of a good shepherd through readings from John 10 and Psalm 23.

The message this Sunday will focus on John 10:14-18, "I AM the Good Shepherd."
