This Sunday, we conclude our sermon series from 1 Corinthians, *The Mind of Christ*. In a culture obsessed with status, intellect, and personal preference, Paul calls the church back to a radically different way of thinking—the mind of Christ. Paul reminds the church of what they have received in Christ, the wisdom of God revealed by the Spirit. Hand in hand with this revelation, followers of God must reject the world's approach to power and remain with God in the Spirit in order to receive the Lord's true gift of grace and life.

The message this Sunday will focus on 1 Corinthians 2:6-16, "The Mind of Christ."
