# **1** THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

**THIS SUNDAY:** We will be worshipping together through one service in person and over live stream at 10:00 a.m. To join us online, go to Bethel's home page and click on the button that says: Worship Online with Us.

This Sunday our advent sermon series, *Behold and Become: Unto us a Child is Born,* continues by reflecting on what it looks like to wait in silence for joy. Centuries pass where the people of God fail to see what must change in order for them to live at peace with God and with one another, resulting in pain, exile and hardship. Fast forward to the New Testament, Israel is governed by foreign powers. The worship of the people is stale, ritualistic and faithlessness. Few encounters capture this more than when an Angel of the Lord comes to Zechariah, a priest in the temple. The angel tells Zechariah that, after many years, his wife, Elizabeth, will have a son. Zechariah questions God and is silenced. Through this silence the Lord works to re-align Zechariah's heart. Unto us a child was born; the Lord works within the silence of advent so that we might prepare room for him in our own lives. When it came time to name the child "John," Zechariah's silence breaks with joy and praise. This should also be our response when Christ shall come.

The message this Sunday will focus on Luke 1:5-25, 57-66, "From Silence to Song."
