THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This Sunday we continue our sermon series, *Cross Through the Cliché*, where we are reflecting on misunderstood sayings about faith from the Bible and culture. Along the way, we will access helpful tools for stepping into a deeper life with Jesus and moving past the cliché to embrace God's heart for us through his word.

Sunday, we will explore the often-used phrase: "Love the Sinner. Hate the Sin." As we unpack the origins of this phrase and explore its connection to Jesus' teachings, we will discover how easily this phrase can be misapplied. This phrase challenges us to a greater measure of Christian love and accountability, pursuing love for our neighbours like God loves; and even to challenge in the world what God hates.

The message this Sunday will engage with Jesus' teachings from Luke 6:27-42 and Luke 10:25-37, "Love like God."

During the service this Sunday we will celebrate with the **KABUYA** family as Elijah & Ify bring their children, **JOY**, **MALAKHI**, **FAITH** & **HOPE**, for the sacrament of baptism.
