1 THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This Sunday we continue our sermon series for Lent, *I AM*. Each of the statements Jesus makes about himself in the Gospel of John invite us to follow Christ more fully because of who he is, and not what we would prefer him to be. Next, we look at what it means for Jesus to be the "light of the world." Light in Scripture is a powerful image that draws us into an incredible truth: through Jesus, God exposes darkness and evil out in the world and within us. Not only this, but God shows us how we can embrace the "light of life" in relationship with him. May Christ shine in our hearts this Sunday and show us the way forward.

The message this Sunday will focus on John 8:12-20, "I AM the Light of the World."

Following the message, we will celebrate the Lord's Supper together. For those attending in-person, we will invite you to come forward to receive the elements at the front, sharing them together as a group. If you are not able to come forward, please raise your hand and the elements will be brought to you. Gluten-free bread is available for those who desire this option.

For everyone online, please have communion elements ready at home (bread, juice/wine) to join with us in sharing the meal. You can partake of the elements at home while they are being served in the sanctuary.

We look forward to celebrating Christ's meal of grace with you Sunday. Please prepare you hearts for this time of remembrance and celebration in light of our forgiveness through the cross.
