O THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This Sunday we will be wrapping up our sermon series on *Habits of the Church* by reflecting on Paul and Silas' demonstration of praise and the witness it was one dark night in a Philippian prison. The message, "And to Praise and Witness." will take us through three movements that are repeated throughout Scripture; Believe. Change. Tell. By examining this pattern more closely, we'll see how praise brings light and life to the darkness; how it breaks chains and shackles, opens prison doors, and brings the greatest freedom and joy that can ever be found.

This week's scripture is from Acts 16:16-34. For memorization, consider verse 31, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved..."
