### **O** THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This Sunday, September 21, we continue our fall sermon series, *Habits of the Church*. The Book of Acts gives us a picture of a church alive with purpose, passion, and power, modeling six habits that shaped the early church: devotion to God's Word, life-giving fellowship, the breaking of bread, powerful prayer, generosity and worshipful witness. It's the table that unites us. The first church was a community, not just a crowd. Fellowship went beyond casual friendliness—it was a committed sharing of life, faith, resources, and burdens. This message will unpack the biblical idea of breaking bread, how it reminds us of the Lord's Supper, community, and hospitality in a way that strengthen believers and makes them ready to testify to the world about Jesus.

The message this Sunday will focus on Acts 2:42-47, "To the Breaking of Bread."
