This Sunday we continue the *I AM* sermon series during Lent. Each of the statements Jesus makes about himself in the Gospel of John invites us to follow Christ more fully because of **who he is** and not what we would prefer him to be. Next, we look at Jesus' promise that he is the "The Way, the Truth, and the Life." Jesus reminds his disciples that if they trust in him, they do not need to fear. He then explains how knowing who Jesus is leads them to know and understand who the Father is. We will explore what Jesus means as he calls himself the WAY.

The message this Sunday will focus on from John 14:5-14, "I AM the Way, the Truth, and the Life."
