# **TODAY'S SERVICE**

**THIS SUNDAY:** We will be worshipping together through one service in person and over live stream at 10:00 a.m. To join us online, go to Bethel's home page and click on the button that says: "Worship Online With Us."

On Sunday, we will wrap up our sermon series, "Flourish: Life by the Spirit," by reflecting on self-control, the last fruit of the Spirit Paul lists in Galatians 5. This original list contrasts the fruits of those walk in step with the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23) with those who live according to their own way – out of control (Galatians 5:19-21). The only way we release our own attempts to control our lives is to surrender them to God, and we only do this when God's grace appears to us. It is God's grace that compels us to say "yes" to following Jesus; and it is God's grace that enables us to say "no" to the world (and ourselves at times). This is exactly what Paul instructs Titus about God's grace: If we hear it, receive it, and practice it – we will have all we need, by the power of the spirit, to flourish in life, resisting sin and cultivating self-controlled, godly lives.

Our message Sunday will focus on Titus 2:11-14 "The Freedom and Discipline of Surrender".
